Arlington Police are seeking assistance in identifying a suspect in an aggravated robbery occurring on Monday, December 14, 2009 at around 3:38 p.m. The suspect entered into the Cash America Pawn store located in the 100 block of South Collins Street. After posing as a customer, the suspect displayed a handgun and stole items from a display case. The suspect left the store last seen walking south from the store.

The suspect is described as a black male, approximately 30 - 35 years old, 5' 11" – 6' 00", heavy build and a goatee. He was wearing a blue/white/grey long sleeve shirt, matching toboggan style hat, and dark blue or black jeans.
