





What are The Qualifications for COP Mobile?

- Must be a minimum of 21 years of age or older at the time of application.
- Must have successfully completed the 12hr Citizens on Patrol New Member Orientation Training Program.
- Must be able to successfully pass a departmental conducted criminal history check.
- Must be able to successfully pass a departmental conducted driving history check.
- Must consent to an annual criminal and driving history check to ensure proper conduct and maintain program integrity.
- Must be able to present proof of liability insurance coverage for your personal vehicle(s).

Members meeting all of the above requirements will then be able to submit interest to join the COP Mobile Field Training Program.

- Trainees will undergo 24hrs of hours of documented/evaluated patrol training with an active COP Mobile Trainer(s).
- This training must be completed within a period of no greater than 6months after completion of the 12hr Citizens on Patrol Course.
- After successful completion of the 24hr Field Training, trainees must successfully pass a COP Mobile Standard Operating Procedures exam.
- All trainees will then undergo a formal review by the Community Support Bureau Sergeant.
- If approved to proceed as a member of the COP Mobile program, trainees will become Probationary Members (Probationary period is 12months).
